Specifically, Radio Bath CIO provides local news and other information of benefit to the community, and interviews over 1,000 guests each year. We also bring the community together through our own events, as well as the media partner for the Bath Half marathon, Peasedown Party in the Park, the Rotary Club's fireworks display, and many other events.

Radio Bath CIO is now seeking to create a Community Media Hub to provide opportunities for people of all ages to gain confidence in their digital media skills, explore their creativity and improve their educational and employability prospects.

- Work collaboratively with the production team to plan show content, music playlists and interviews.
